### Resume pointers

- Be honest!
- Fit all of your resume on one page
- Utilize strong action verbs
- Quantify results with your experiences
- Only include parts of your resume in which you stand out (i.e. Do not include proficiency in Microsoft Word)
- Put your resume in chronological order
- Print off your resume on cardstock/resume paper
- Ensure name consistency and proper formatting
- Try to have equal number of bullet points for each position


