Select the following appointment details. (Some items only show up after you make initial selections.)

- 1. Category: Select Advising
- 2. Advising/Tutoring Unit: Select College of Social Science Advising
- 3. **Appointment Reason:** Click the look-up/magnifying glass icon and select Human Resource Labor Relations OR Leadership of Organizations. Do not search for Human Resource Labor Relations OR Leadership of Organizations in the text box. Instead, you can also type "0803" to search for HRLR or "0173" to search for L of Org.
- 4. Appointment Duration: This will default to 30 minutes. There is no option to change it.
- 5. Additional Information (required): If you select a phone appointment, please include your phone number/skype ID/WeChat ID in this section that you would like to be reached at and I will call the listed number/ID at the scheduled appointment time. Please also enter the reason for your appointment to help me prepare, e.g., scheduling classes, graduation check, etc.
- 6. Appointment Type: Select your preference of a Phone, Zoom or In-Person appointment. If you select Zoom, you can access my Zoom meeting information within the automated email you receive AFTER scheduling the appointment.
