POSSIBLE NON-SHRLR ELECTIVES AT MSU

Elective courses for the MHRLR degree may be selected from courses offered by the SHRLR and other departments within Michigan State University. Given the importance of learning concepts in the core knowledge areas of the SHRLR curriculum, students are only able to take one of their elective courses outside of the School.

Three courses have been pre-approved by our faculty, among which students can enroll without further authorization. These pre-approved courses include:
