

### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Join our four-session immersive online course in May 2026 to equip yourself with the foundational legal knowledge, process fluency, and practical judgment that distinguish highly effective arbitrators, union advocates, HR professionals, and labor relations leaders.

This course covers foundational aspects of labor arbitration, while also exploring advanced arbitral topics:

- Application of just-cause in the context of disciplinary matters, and the implications of past practice with respect to contract interpretation.
- Public-sector considerations, including interest arbitration, and Constitutional protections applicable within the public sector.
- Post-arbitration considerations, including enforcement and appeals of arbitration awards, and implications for impacted employeesm including issues relating to personnel records.

This program lays out a clear plan to support your success, with sessions that build upon one another and address various aspects and issues arising within labor arbitration.
